Recommendations for next phase of C-51 Reservoir Study

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Phase 2A Study

- Task Force briefed on Phase 2A study results November 2009
- Task Force also discussed C-51 study at the December 2009 and January 2010 meetings
- Phase 2A Report finalized in January
- District met with study sponsors and other interested parties twice in February



SFWMD Comments

Proposed C-51 Reservoir has potential to be a viable water supply development project

- IF next phase of C-51 Study:
 - Focuses on eastern route via Lake Worth Drainage District
 - Western route will cost 2 or 3 times more
 - Provides appropriate analyses and documentation to show how Regional Water Availability Rule will be met

Project may be able to contribute to solutions needed to address Everglades water quality issues



Emerging Considerations 2010

- Court orders issued by two federal judges in separate cases concerning Everglades water quality
 - Remedies to meet federal court requirements still being defined
 - District is engaged in
 - Discussions with state and federal agencies
 - Additional technical analyses
- EPA's proposed numeric nutrient criteria
 - District working with local, state and federal agencies
 - Impacts still being analyzed

SFWMD Recommendations

- The District identified six key elements that need to be addressed:
- **1.** Refine the utility demand requirements
 - Specific steps are included in District comments
- 2. Develop a water budget analysis associated with reservoir operations



SFWMD Recommendations (continued)

- 3. Demonstrate how water from the reservoir will be routed through Lake Worth Drainage District and Broward secondary canal system to comply with Regional Water Availability Rule
- 4. Conduct modeling to show that the project does not capture water required for the Comprehensive Everglades Restoration Plan*
- Quantify potential secondary benefits to the Arthur R. Marshall Loxahatchee National Wildlife Refuge*

(* The District will provide technical assistance with Recommendations 4 and 5)

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SFWMD Recommendations (continued)

6. Provide evidence of utilities' commitments to fund the C-51 Reservoir Project

- Infrastructure
- Operations and Maintenance
- Necessary actions and documentation of local government commitment to be defined



Conclusions

- If local governments decide to proceed with next phase of C-51 project study, the District:
 - Urges the sponsors to address the six recommendations
 - Will provide technical assistance with two of the recommended tasks



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
